Throughout the school year, but especially in the fall, there are numerous opportunities to meet with college and technical school representatives, military recruiters and prospective employers either at local college and job fairs or through regularly scheduled visits by admissions personnel in the Guidance Center. Students can earn one elective portfolio point each year during freshman and sophomore years and a maximum of four points per year during the junior and senior year for consulting with a college or career representative and documenting their impressions of the contact and the information obtained.

At the conclusion of the contact, the student should write a reflection about the meeting using the prompts below on the College and Career Log.
