What is a student eWallet?

An eWallet is a new, digital payment option that gives students a secure, cash-free way to shop the fair. Parents can pre-authorize a spending amount online, which can be looked up or scanned at checkout. The first step is for parents to create an eWallet account.

How do parents create an eWallet account?

Parents can set up an eWallet account from 10/29 – 11/16 by going to www.scholastic.com/bf/psis208.

Please tell your child the amount that is in the eWallet or send your child with a note to his/her teacher in order that he/she knows how much to spend when they visit the Book Fair with their class.

Can parents create one eWallet for all of their children? No, parents must create an eWallet for each student; accounts cannot be shared or transferred.

How are parents charged for eWallet purchases?

A preauthorization charge will appear on the credit card account in the amount parents select as the eWallet spending limit. Parents will only be charged for what is purchased at the fair (up to the spending limit they selected). On the last day of the in-school book fair, any unspent funds will be released back to the credit card on file.

Can parents add additional funds to an existing eWallet? Yes, additional funds can be added to the eWallet at any time. Parents can also delete eWallets, and any unspent funds would be returned to their credit card.
