a. If we fraudulently claim to have given up custody of our said child(ren) to the said guardian, we will have committed a disorderly persons offense and upon conviction thereof, we may be punished by a fine of up to \$1,000.00, or be imprisoned for up to six months, or both.

We have read and understand the affidavit and the application of the applicant/guardian, and any false statements, answers or declarations contained in this affidavit, or in the affidavit and/or application of the applicant/guardian, may subject us to criminal prosecution for the crime of false swearing in violation of N.J.S.A.2C:28-2, and upon conviction thereof, we may be punished by a fine of up to \$10,000.00, or be imprisoned for up to 18 months, or both.
