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| If your child is absent from school for any reason | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Call the attendance line before 8:30AM• Send a note on your child's day of return• Doctor's note is required for any absence due to a contagious illness (flu, ringworm, chicken pox, pink eye, etc.) |
| 10 consecutive days absent will require you to re-register your child for school | It is possible that a Home Liaison or Truant Officer will make a home visit. |
| 3 days' tardy = 1 day absent | The student will need to make up the work that was missed during the absence. This has the potential of impacting grades and in some cases, promotion. |
| Procedures in case a child must leave school early | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Parent must come into the Main Office and sign the student out of school.• Please no early pick-up after 2:30PM |
