Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Englewood Public School District (EPSD) receives Title III funding from the federal government to help English language learners to speak, read, and write in English and to achieve in reading and mathematics. School districts and other agencies that receive Title III funds are reviewed each year to see if they meet the three Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs) for their English learners.

The indicators are as follows:

- Progress in learning English @ 59 % or higher- **EPSD met this target.**
- Progress in the percentage of students who become proficient in English **TARGET #2:**
5% of students enrolled year 1-4 must attain a score of 4.5
50% of students enrolled 5 years or more must attain a score of 4.5

For the 2014-2015 school year, EPSD did not meet AMAO due to the following schools not meeting TARGET #2.

**DWIGHT MORROW HIGH SCHOOL- 38.5%.
JANIS DISMUS MIDDLE SCHOOL- 21.4%**

- Academic targets in English-language arts and mathematics- **EPSD met this target.**
