WHEREAS, the Clark Board of Education adopted a tentative budget on March 19, 2018 to be submitted to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on April 18, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was advertised in the legal section of the Home News Tribune on April 26, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the final budget was presented to the public during a public hearing on May 2, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the budget for General Fund Expenses shall be \$36,117,280, of which \$31,694,372 shall be raised by tax levy; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the budget for Special Revenue Fund Expense shall be \$968,792, of which \$0.00 shall be raised by tax levy; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the budget for Debt Service Expense shall be \$1,355,032, of which \$1,355,032 shall be raised by tax levy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Clark Board of Education hereby adopts the 2018-2019 School Year budget; and

BE IT RESOLVED that there should be raised for the General Funds \$31,694,372 for the ensuing School Year (2018-2019); and

BE IT RESOLVED that there should be raised for Debt Service Funds \$1,355,032 for the ensuing School Year (2018-2019); and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Clark Board of Education includes in the final budget the adjustment for banked cap in the amount of \$285,821. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.3(b), the district has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority. The adjustment will be used for District Initiatives. The Clark Board of Education will complete this by the end of the 2019 budget year and acknowledges that it cannot be deferred or incrementally completed over a longer period of time.
