\*The two types of modes (how the student will be administered the assessment) are computer and paper-based. Be sure to inquire about the options if your son/daughter has an issue that would not allow him/her to take the assessment on the computer. The NJSLA testing window for the paper-based administration is April 20, 2020 – May 1, 2020. Specific dates for building level administration will be determined.

\*The testing times indicated refer to the maximum amount of time allotted to students to complete the assessment.

\*The testing dates are the period in which districts administer the NJSLA assessment. It is not the actual number of days it takes a student to test. School districts can choose which days within the testing window to assess students.

\*Results available refers to when score reports will be available to the district. The district will send out reports to the parents as soon as possible.

\*The Science Assessment Administration testing window for the paper-based administration is May 4, 2020 - May 15, 2020.
