

Elementary Students

It is against the school rules for any student or adult who works at your school to treat anyone badly or differently in any way just because they:

1. look different;
2. act different;
3. are younger or older;
4. a boy or a girl;
5. are from another country;
6. go to a different church, temple, or mosque;
7. are skinny or not skinny;
8. have a different color skin;
9. are handicapped or can't do the same things that you can;
10. like boys or like girls;
11. are different from you in any way.

This includes saying hurtful words and/or doing hurtful things either in person, on a computer, or in any other way. If you know of anyone that does not follow these rules, please tell a teacher, the assistant principal, or the principal.

These rules apply during the entire school day. You must follow the rules when you are on school property (both inside and outside the building), while on the school bus, while on field trips, or any other school event or activity.
