TO: Parents, Teachers, Staff and School Organizations

This letter is addressed to parents, teachers, employees and organizations in our school district as required by the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). This act requires all schools to inform its employees and building occupants about certain asbestos related activities and records.

The EPA requires the District to perform a visual inspection of any existing asbestos every six months, as well as an in depth detailed triennial inspection. The triennial inspection was performed in June 2013.

During the past six month period asbestos abatement took place in the following areas:

Hutchinson School

- Remove asbestos floor tile in classroom #02.
- Remove asbestos floor tile in small corridor closet -ground floor.
- Remove asbestos floor tile in classroom 103.

Colonial School

- Remove asbestos floor tile in classroom #107.

All removal and air testing was performed in accordance with NYS AHERA standards and the air test results are available in the facilities office.

Remaining asbestos in our schools will be surveyed every six months so that it may be maintained in good condition. Prior to any asbestos abatement projects, students, faculty and staff will be provided with specific project information ten days prior to project commencement.
