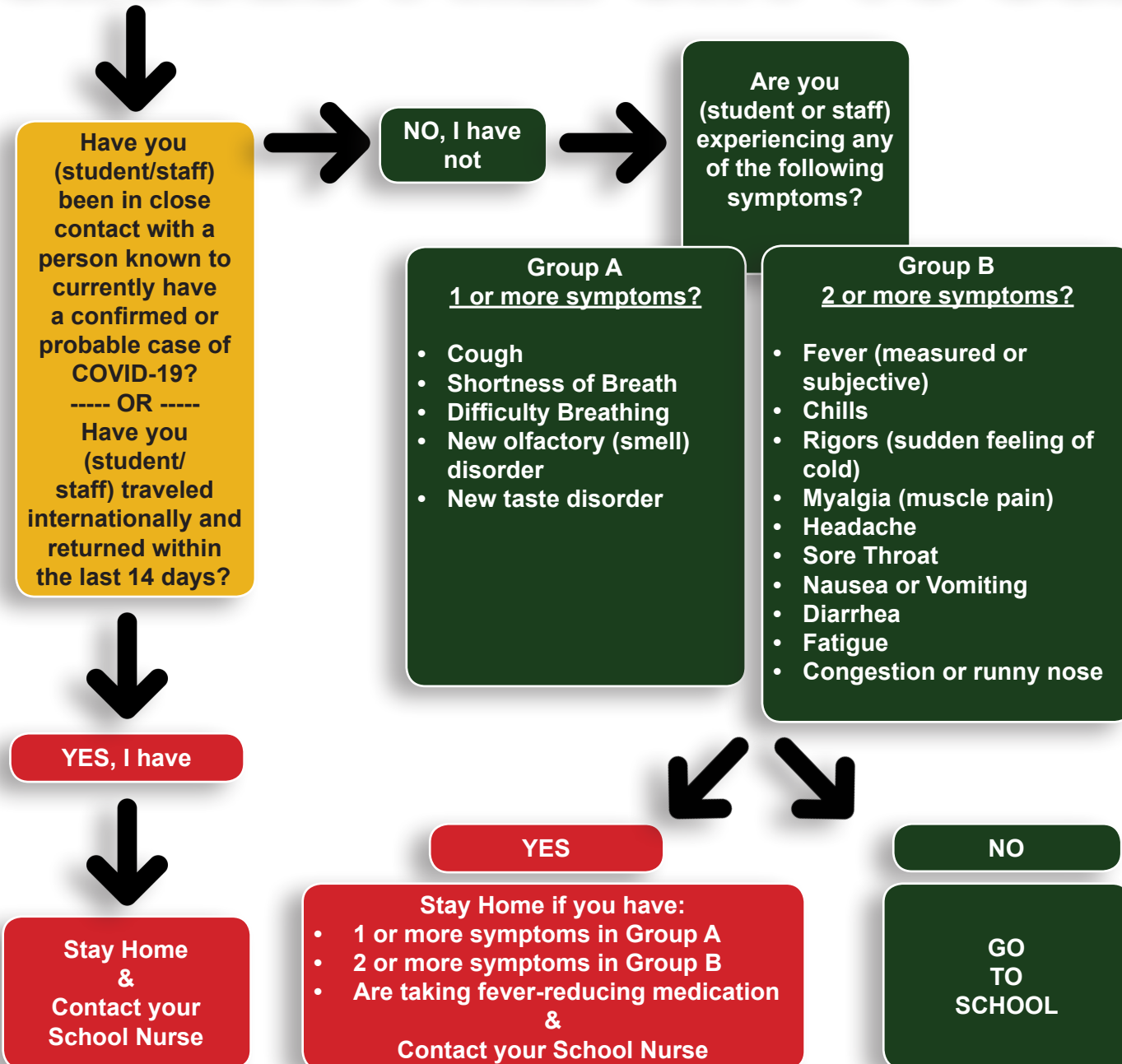


SHOULD I REPORT TO SCHOOL?



- Staff and students should NOT come to school and must notify school officials if they become sick with COVID-19 symptoms, test positive for COVID-19, or are exposed to someone with COVID-19 symptoms or to someone with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19.
- No students with symptoms will be sent on a bus or brought to school.
- All staff will perform a symptom screen on themselves before leaving for work and will stay home if ill.
- Parents/guardians/staff will report possible COVID-19 symptoms and/or exposure to School Nurse after using the self-assessment tool.
- Staff and students with fever or symptoms associated with COVID-19 but no known direct exposure to a person with COVID-19 may return to school when they are asymptomatic and have been fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medicine or have confirmation of an alternative diagnosis from a health care provider that explains the COVID-19 like symptom(s).
