- Review Emails:
 - An email was received with a photo of broken desks and chairs in Room 367 @ NRHS the proper person has been advised to remove them from the classroom.
- Discussion re: ALMS students going to an event today, Friday May 17th on Charter Busses. The busses arrived late. There are questions as to what should protocol have been.
 - Suggestion: District Bus Protocol information should be sent to Bus Company before event.
 - There were complaints that Parents were not advised of what was happening. Who should have been responsible to notify parents?
 - There will be future discussions to create protocol for situations like this and The Bus Protocol will be reviewed again and submitted to Administration and the Board before being voted upon.
- April 5th meeting minutes were reviewed and approved
- The Security Dept. is continuing to find a solution for the location of a Master Key for each building.
 - Suggestion was to use a combination key pad at multiple locations outside the buildings and then a location in the building for interior masters and maps.
- Color code numbering: Over the summer Mr. Daniele and Mr. Newman are planning to “tighten up” the system in place to “better” color code the High School so next year there will be a slight modification of what is already in place. The ultimate goal is to have the same system in place in all District Schools. This system is for First Responders and Visitors.
- There was continued discussion re: students hanging out at McDonald's, it was suggested that the proprietor hire private police to be on the premises. It was mentioned that the students are there after school hours, the School District will work with the community to deal with these issues, it is a collaborative effort. Dr. Parvey advised, at this time they are not having a conversation re: opening up the campus.
