










# SAMPLE BALLOT

## INSTRUCTIONS - TWO-SIDED BALLOT:

- 1) Mark only with a writing instrument provided by the School District.
- 2) You will find the title of the Public Office being contested, the term, and a direction stating the number you may vote for.
- 3) To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot, fill in the oval  to the right of the candidate's name like this: ●
- 4) To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot, write in or stamp his or her name in the blank space labeled "WRITE-IN" at the bottom of the column for such office. A WRITE-IN name cannot match a candidate's name already pre-printed on this ballot. Should a voter write in a candidate's name already listed on this ballot, it will not be counted, as that would be construed as an attempt to double-vote.
- 5) To vote YES or NO on a proposition that appears on the back of the ballot, fill in the oval  below the proposition that corresponds with your vote, like this: ● If you fill in both YES and NO ovals for the same proposition, it will be considered an overvote and, therefore, your ballot will be void for that proposition.
- 6) Any other mark or writing or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for voting will void this entire ballot.
- 7) Do not overvote. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your ballot will be void for that public office.
- 8) If you tear, or deface, or wrongly mark this ballot, return it and obtain another from an Election Inspector. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making erasures or crossouts. Erasures or crossouts may invalidate all or part of your ballot. Prior to submitting your ballot, if you make a mistake in completing the ballot or wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot upon return of the original ballot to an Election Inspector.
- 9) After completing your ballot, insert into the ballot scanner and wait for the notice that your ballot has been successfully scanned. If no such notice appears, seek the assistance of an Election Inspector.

2018-2019 GENERAL FUND BUDGET PROPOSITION No. 1**

**SCHOOL DISTRICT  
PROPOSITION No. 2 - CAPITAL RESERVE FUND**

**RESOLVED**, that the general fund proposed budget of expenditures of the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of New Rochelle, Westchester County, New York, for the 2018-2019 school year in the amount of \$272,804,093 for the purposes shown in the statement of estimated expenditures be and hereby is approved and authorized to be submitted to the voters at the Annual School Election/Budget Vote, May 15, 2018; and, the amount thereof shall be raised by a levy of a tax upon taxable property located within the School District, and, after deducting the monies available from State Aid and other sources as provided by law? The adoption of this budget requires a tax levy increase of 3.89% which exceeds the statutory tax levy increase limit of 2.23% for this school fiscal year; and, therefore, exceeds the state tax cap and must be approved by sixty percent of the qualified voters present and voting.

Shall the Board of Education of the City School District of New Rochelle, New York (the "School District") be authorized to establish a new capital reserve fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 3651 of the Education Law to pay costs of the construction, reconstruction, renovation, expansion and equipping of School District buildings and other facilities, including original equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, furnishings and other incidental improvements in connection therewith, in an ultimate amount of \$10,000,000, having a probable term of twenty (20) years and be authorized to raise \$10,000,000 to fund such capital reserve fund in the current or future years through the payments received by the School District from the Fair Share Mitigation Fund established pursuant to the City of New Rochelle's zoning plan for the Downtown Overlay Zone and/or any other legally available funds of the School District?
