NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND
SPECIAL DISTRICT MEETING – BUDGET RE-VOTE**

GENERAL INFORMATION: Time and Place of Voting; Voter Registration; Absentee Ballots

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Special District Meeting - Budget Re-Vote of the City School District of the City of New Rochelle will be held Tuesday, June 19, 2018, between the hours of 7:00 AM and 9:00 PM, at which time the polls will be opened to vote by voting machine upon the items described below.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with the resolution adopted by the New Rochelle Board of Education, the City School District is divided into thirteen (13) School Election Districts (SED) at which voting will take place. A description of the boundaries of each School Election District is on file in the office of the School District Clerk, Central Administration, 515 North Avenue, New Rochelle, New York 10801, and is available for inspection Mondays through Fridays (except holidays) between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:30 PM. The locations of the polling places are as follows:

SED #12 - Ward School, 311 Broadfield Road, New Rochelle, NY 10804, Cafeteria (Rear Entrance) (G.E.D.: 27, 33, 42, 67)

SED #13 - 570 Fifth Avenue, New Rochelle, NY 10801, Community Room (G.E.D.: 21)

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that all registered voters in the City of New Rochelle will receive, by mail, a budget notice, which specifically identifies the polling place at which such voter shall vote. This notice will be mailed no later than June 13, 2018. Any person who has moved from one School Election District to another, within the City School District of New Rochelle, and who has not registered in the new School Election District, and who is still registered in the district from which he/she moved, may vote in the election district in which he/she is registered. Such person must at the time of voting advise the Election Inspectors of his/her new address and they shall advise the Board of Registration to correct such registration.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Registration will meet at the Board of Education offices, 515 North Avenue, New Rochelle, New York, on Tuesday, June 5, 2018, between the hours of 4:00 PM and 8:00 PM, for the purpose of registering those qualified voters who are not already registered with the Westchester County Board of Elections. A qualified voter is one who is (1) a citizen of the United States; and (2) eighteen (18) years of age or older; and (3) a resident within the District for a period of thirty (30) days next preceding the Special District Meeting - Budget Re-Vote, June 19, 2018; and (4) registered to vote with the City School District of New Rochelle or with the Westchester County Board of Elections in accordance with Section 5-106 of the Election Law which excludes (a) those convicted of a felony pursuant to the laws of New York State, who have not been pardoned or had their rights of citizenship restored, those whose maximum sentence of imprisonment has not expired, and/or those who have not been discharged from parole; and (b) persons adjudged incompetent by order of a court of competent judicial authority.

One must be registered to vote at the Special District Meeting on June 19, 2018. The registers prepared by the Board of Registration shall be open for inspection by any qualified voter of the District at the Board of Education offices, 515 North Avenue, between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:30 PM, Mondays through Fridays (except holidays) commencing June 5, 2018.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots may be obtained from the office of the School District Clerk, 515 North Avenue, New Rochelle, New York 10801, telephone No. (914) 576-4219, or downloaded from the School District's Website, www.nred.org. Completed original applications must be received by the School District Clerk, 515 North Avenue, no later than 5:00 PM on Tuesday, June 12, 2018, if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter; and no later than 5:00 PM on Monday, June 18, 2018, if the ballot is to be issued personally to the voter. The absentee ballot must be received by the School District Clerk, 515 North Avenue, no later than 5:00 PM on June 19, 2018, in order to be included in the canvass of votes. A list of persons to whom absentee ballots

shall have been issued will be available for public inspection by any qualified voter between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM Mondays through Fridays (except holidays) commencing June 5, 2018 until the day of the election at the office of the School District Clerk, 515 North Avenue, New Rochelle, New York 10801. Any qualified voter may, upon examination of such list, file a written challenge of the qualifications as a voter of any person whose name appears on such list, stating the reasons for such challenge. Such written challenge shall be transmitted by the School District Clerk to the Election Inspectors on the day of the Vote. Any qualified voter present in the polling place has the right to object to the voting of an absentee ballot upon appropriate grounds for making his/her challenge and the reasons therefore known to an Election Inspector before the close of the polls.

SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET AND ELECTION INFORMATION:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing on the Proposed 2018-2019 Annual Budget of the City School District of the City of New Rochelle will be held Tuesday, June 5, 2018 at 7:00 PM in the Library at New Rochelle High School, 265 Clove Road, New Rochelle.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Special District Meeting - Budget Re-Vote of the City School District of the City of New Rochelle will be held Tuesday, June 19, 2018, between the hours of 7:00 AM and 9:00 PM, at which time the polls will be opened to vote by voting machine upon the following item:

1. To adopt the Annual Budget of the City School District of the City of New Rochelle for the fiscal year 2018-2019, and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property located within the School District, New Rochelle, New York as follows:

SCHOOL DISTRICT 2018-2019 GENERAL FUND BUDGET PROPOSITION

RESOLVED, that the general fund proposed budget of expenditures of the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of New Rochelle, Westchester County, New York, for the 2018-2019 school year in the amount of \$270,381,160 for the purposes shown in the statement of estimated expenditures be and hereby is approved and authorized to be submitted to the voters at the Special District Meeting, June 19, 2018; and, the amount thereof shall be raised by a levy of a tax upon taxable property located within the School District, and, after deducting the monies available from State Aid and other sources as provided by law?

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required to fund the School District's budget for 2018-2019, exclusive of public monies, may be obtained by any resident of the School District during business hours, 8:00 AM through 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday, except holidays, at the School District's administrative offices, 515 North Avenue, New Rochelle, New York 10801, and all school buildings within the School District, commencing June 5, 2018.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Real Property Tax Exemption Report prepared in accordance with Section 495 of the Real Property Tax Law will be annexed to any

tentative/preliminary budget as well as the final adopted budget of which it will form a part; and shall be posted on the District bulletin board(s) maintained for public notices, as well as on the District's website.
