PROOF OF RESIDENCY REGULATIONS
FOR PARENTS ENROLLING A STUDENT IN PRESTON PUBLIC
SCHOOLS FOR THE FIRST TIME

Before any student is assigned or invited to attend Preston Public Schools for the first time, the student's parent or legal guardian* must prove legal residence in the Town of Preston. Families whose primary residence is outside of Preston are not eligible to attend Preston Public Schools.

Effective immediately, all applicants must submit at least **three proofs of residency**. These documents also will be required for any **change of address**.

Documents must be pre-printed with the name and address of the student's parents or guardian* and must be presented at Preston Veterans Memorial School. Preston Public Schools will only record the presentation of these documents, but will not make copies of them.

All applicants must present to the Principal one document from <u>each</u> of the following columns:

*Legal guardianship requires additional documentation from a court or agency.

NOTE: If you have children already enrolled in Preston Public Schools, you do not need to complete these residency requirements.
