RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby continues the appointment and designation of Ms. Rhonda Taylor as Acting Superintendent to act in the place of the Superintendent of Schools and continues the authorization of Ms. Taylor to take all actions and have all the authority and responsibilities under law, regulation, rule or Board policy otherwise associated with the position of Superintendent of Schools; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Ms. Taylor shall continue to serve as the District's Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction during such appointment and designation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that during the period of such appointment and designation, in exchange for the added duties and responsibilities attendant thereto, Ms. Taylor shall continue to receive additional compensation as previously approved by the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such appointment, designation and authority shall continue through November 2, 2020 or until the Superintendent of Schools returns from his current absence, whichever occurs first, unless such term is modified by the Board of Education.
