RESOLUTION SHOWING TABULATION OF VOTES CAST AND DECLARATION OF THE RESULTS OF THE BALLOT AT ANNUAL DISTRICT ELECTION, HELD IN UNIONDALE UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF HEMPSTEAD, NEW YORK ON May 16, 2017.

Whereas, the Annual District election of the Uniondale Union Free School District of the Town of Hempstead, New York, was duly called to be held on May 16, 2017 and was held on said date in each of the two (2) Election Districts within said School District for the purpose of voting on the Proposition and Election of Trustees set forth in the notice calling said Annual District Election:
