VOTER INFORMATION

NEW VOTING LOCATIONS

Voting for the 2018 Bond Referendum will take place at your local elementary school.

VOTER QUALIFICATIONS

- A citizen of the United States who is eighteen years of age or over.
- A resident in the District for thirty days or more preceding the day of the vote.
- Those who are registered for either school district or general elections, or have voted in a general or school election within the last four years.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained by downloading the application form from the [Absentee Ballot Download](#) tab on the Bond 2018 home page, from the district clerk (call 560-8945), or by picking up an application from the district clerk's office between 8:00AM - 4:00PM on Tuesday, Thursday or Friday prior to the election. The district clerk's office is located in the administrative offices at Uniondale High School, 933 Goodrich Street, Uniondale. You can come to the district clerk's office in person to pick up an application up to the day before the vote. All absentee ballots must be filed with the district clerk by 5:00PM on the day of the election – Thursday, March 15, 2018. For more information, call the district clerk's office at 560-8945.
