



**Junior Academy Uniform Policy:**  
 (Updated for 2018 – 2019 School Year)

	<b>Boys</b>	<b>Girls</b>
<b>Shirt</b>	Solid white polo or oxford shirt tucked into pants	Solid white polo or oxford shirt or shirts
<b>Pants and Skirts</b>	Solid khaki pants or shorts worn at the waist with a neutral colored belt	<p>Solid khaki skirt worn no more than three inches above the knee            (Solid white, black, brown, gray or navy tights or leggings (NO PRINTS) may be worn with a uniform skirt)</p> <p>or</p> <p>Solid khaki pants or shorts worn no more than three inches above the knee            (Pants, shorts and skirts with belt-loops must be worn with a neutral color belt)</p>

<b>Shoes and Socks</b>	<p><b>* Student Requested and Honored Uniform Change*</b></p> <p>Any closed toe and school appropriate shoe (no slides or flip flops) that will not distract from the learning environment (no bright or neon colors)</p> <p>Students participated in a focus group and changed the wording and expectation of the shoe policy</p>	
<b>Hair</b>	All hair and facial hair should be neat and groomed with respect to cultural norms.	

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Jackets and Sweaters</b></p>	<p>Students may wear the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Outerwear purchased Tommy Hilfiger <a href="http://www.globalschoolwear.com/">http://www.globalschoolwear.com/</a> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-specifically: the V-Neck Cardigan Sweater</li> <li>-V-Neck Pullover Sweater Vest</li> <li>-Polar Fleece Zip Front Jacket</li> </ul> </li> <li>-Official Drew athletic pull over zip-up jackets purchased as part of participation in a sport</li> <li>- Forest green, tan or white sweaters (the collar should be visible)</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><u><i>All other outerwear, including but not limited to jackets, vests, sweatshirts, hoodies and shooting shirts, non- Drew items, should be stored during the school day</i></u></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Other</b></p>	<p>When approved by the administration select team and spirit clothing may be allowed on particular school days, in addition to planned dress down</p> <p>Consequences for disregarding uniform policy could include, but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-parent contacted for replacement items</li> <li>-school provides replacement uniform items (shoes, shirts etc.)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> families are expected to return the items washed and folded, when/if appropriate</li> <li>-refusal to adhere to expectations could result in administrative consequences</li> </ul> <p>- All accessories should be consistent with the spirit of the uniform policy.</p> <p>-Head coverings are only allowed for religious reasons inside of the school building (no bandanas).</p>
