



## Drew Charter School's CCRPI Scores Significantly Exceed the State and District Averages

This week, the Georgia Department of Education released the 2018 College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) scores, a 0-100 scaled score that measures a school's academic achievement and growth. Drew's scores significantly exceeded the state and district averages for all academies.

Academy highlights include:

All Academies (Elementary, Junior and Senior Academies)

- Earned 4 climate stars for school climate
- Increased or maintained their rank in the district and state

Senior Academy

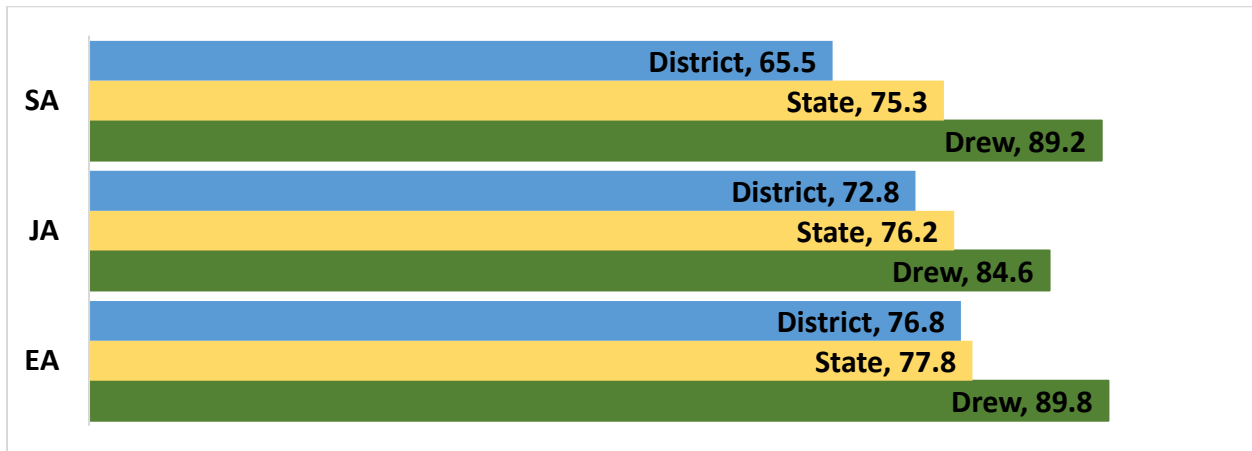
- Highest CCRPI score in the district!
- Met all school subgroup achievement targets
- 3<sup>rd</sup> highest growth in the district

Junior Academy

- Highest growth percentage in the district!
- Fourth highest in the district for Readiness, which measures literacy, attendance and arts participation

Elementary Academy

- Moved up from the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile in the state (2017) to the 92<sup>nd</sup> percentile (2018)
- Earned 90 percent or more for both achievement and growth
