

NON-RESIDENT ATTENDANCE - TUITION

The Board of Education holds in high regard the need for continuity in environment as well as consistency in goals and choice of curricular opportunities. It further recognizes the performance of individuals wishing to participate in the programs offered by the Shelton School System.

In view of the fact that public education is available to all Connecticut residents, the Shelton Board of Education will accept out-of-district students who agree to the following criteria:

1. Any student who becomes a nonresident of Shelton during the school year and who wishes to complete that school year in the Shelton System will be charged a pro-rated tuition rate.*
2. Any student who desires to attend the Shelton School System, but does not live in Shelton, will be charged the full tuition.*
3. All applicants are acceptable on a “space available” status, providing they exhibit and maintain positive academic and behavioral standards. Seniors should be in a position to graduate with their class in order to continue at Shelton High School.

In the case of a special education student, tuition and all related education costs will be paid by the Board of Education of the community in which the student legally resides.

**The tuition rate for each school year will be calculated by dividing the current budget by enrollment as of 9/30 of that current academic year. (cf. 3240 –tuition Fees)*
