 - Coversheet Report and Individual School Feedback Report Evidence
 - Time will be needed to analyze the report

- Concern is focused on the “level of implementation” and individual school self-ranking
 - We may have to develop a menu of evidence to choose from in order to quantify and unify information and feedback to a greater degree
 - We may need to calibrate “understanding of indicators” to unify ranked outcomes
 - Process vs. Product
 - Define Tier 1 in order to calibrate
- Pull together a team of representatives to discuss the survey product and infuse change
 - Intermediate and High School Survey results will be conducted in the May DDT meeting
