Re: School Buses and Kindergarten Bus Stops



Welcome to the Shelton school system! Whether this is your introduction to our system, or you are a veteran with older students in school, the school bus will be a big part of your child's new experience. We hope the following information will be helpful to you in making your plans for the fall semester. Kindergarten students will ride the same school buses and be assigned bus stop locations similar to Grades 1-4 students.

All Kindergarten students:

- Must have an adult waiting at the bus stop when being discharged from the bus.
- In case of an emergency that will cause you to be late, please contact your child's school.
- Kindergarten students who do not have an adult waiting at their bus stops will be returned to their respective school.
- If you will not require bus transportation for your child for the school year, please advise your school as soon as possible.
- You must notify the school in writing of any changes in transportation during the school year. Please do this at least one week before the change takes place.

Daycare:

Transportation can be provided to and/or from a Daycare provider **within** your child's home school district, and the Boy's and Girl's Club, if the bus route does not need to be altered and space is available, this is done out of consideration for working parents. The Daycare provider must be a consistent stop, done on consistent days of the week. Daycare requests for the beginning of the school year should reach us as early as possible to assure your child's correct transportation. If you do not notify your school or our office in writing, we will assume that your child will ride the bus to/from his/her assigned home bus stop.

Please note the Transportation Department is working during the summer months. We will publish bus runs on the Shelton Public Schools website prior to the start of the school year. Please understand that these runs, including bus stop locations, bus stop times and bus numbers, might change as bus stops are added or deleted due to relocations, new student enrollments and daycare requests.
