

COMPARABILITY OF SERVICES

The Shelton Board of Education recognizes the need to ensure comparability of services funded by local and state revenues in both Title 1 schools and non-Title 1 schools. The Board of Education will therefore:

- Adopt a district-wide salary schedule for all certified employees as specified in the teachers contract.
- Provide services with state and local monies in schools serving Title 1 project attendance areas that are of at least comparable to services in non-project attendance areas.
- Use state and local funds to provide for equivalence among all schools with the same grade levels in teachers, administrators and support personnel.
- Use state and local funds to provide for equivalence among all schools with the same grade levels in the provision of curriculum and instructional materials, books and supplies.

As trustees of the community's investment in plant, facilities and operational funds, the Board has a responsibility to ensure that the investment is protected and used wisely. Competent personnel and efficient procedures are essential for sound management of fiscal affairs. Board members expect the Superintendent and the Director of Finance to keep them informed through reports, both oral and written, of the fiscal management of the school system.
