- **Discussion of Substitute Bill #5308** – see handout – Tina Henckel – 5 min
 - Handout outlined the act concerning revisions to the *Framework for Response to Intervention*
- **SRBI follow-up** — Tina Henckel & Vicky White – 20 min
 - The Ad Hoc Team that was responsible for the revisions presented to the district in PL activities in August/September 2015 – the team collected information and data on the revision process to evaluate the changes to the district-wide process
 - Ad Hoc Committee Members will become part of a team’s review of existing practice
 - Next school year will be an assessment year regarding, practice, fidelity, implementation, and monitoring
 - The district may be creating model videos of data team “effective” practices for system-wide use

 - School based information to “drill down”, analyze, discussion – “use these discussions as laboratories for further thought and analysis

 - How would this look - Discussion – sharing and patterns for meetings and data
 - Outline/Create Topics
 - This will result in more focused meetings as well as more attention to the district assessment calendars
 - Variations on Practice

- **Next Generation Accountability System** – Tina Henckel – 20 min
 - Quick Overview – theoretically replaces “No Child Left Behind”
 - This was present to “all administrators” at last All Admins Meeting to outline basic framework and factors
 - 12 indicators – see handout – Accountability and Performance indexes
 - Overall district accountability was 82.3% in Shelton – State = 76.1%
 - State has quantified “Targets”
 - The reports have incorporated “gap analysis” into the outcomes – noting schools that have reduced the differentials between student performance and ranking – doing a better job at improving student performance and

achievement and exceeding “norms” thereby becoming a “school of distinction” – Shelton schools could be counted in this group with focus on improvement, student achievement, indicator success, and effective instruction
