

Bylaws of the Board

Formulation, Adoption, Amendment of Bylaws

Policy proposals and suggested amendments to, deletions of, or revisions of existing bylaws shall normally be submitted to all members of the Board of Education by the Superintendent in writing prior to a regularly scheduled Board of Education meeting in which such proposed policies, amendments or revisions thereof shall be read and discussed.

Bylaws will, unless otherwise provided by vote of two-thirds of the members present of the Board of Education, be adopted or amended after consideration at two regular meetings of the Board of Education. The agenda and minutes shall be marked to indicate bylaw matters.

The formal adoption of bylaws shall be by two-thirds vote of the entire membership of the Board, and the action shall be recorded in the minutes of the Board of Education.

Written notice for bylaw action shall be issued according to Freedom of Information regulations.
