- **Draft School Climate Survey for discussion** – Lis Wesolowski/K. Riddle 20 min
  - Draft surveys and timelines were passed out and discussed
  - It is important to note that at the end of the first set of survey questions a parent could be prompted to answer another set of questions for another school or for another student in their family to make taking the survey more convenient for parents to take
  - Student survey responses will include 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade on school surveys when student surveys are delivered
  - The committee discussed a variety of “parent survey” questions in order to create a more uniform bank for system-wide use – review and revision completed
