The health, safety, and welfare of students and staff continues to be a top priority for the Yough School District and we will continue to follow the guidelines of the Pennsylvania Department of Education and the Department of Health regarding our instructional model. Students will remain in school through Wednesday, November 25. On November 25, the early dismissal times are listed below.

High School 11:00 am
Middle School 11:45 am
Elementary Schools 12:30 pm

The district is notifying parents that IF the county remains in the "substantial" designation over the Thanksgiving Holiday, we will move to Full Virtual Instruction upon return from break on Tuesday, December 1, 2020.


The district will contact parents, no later than Monday, November 30, 2020, once final designations of "moderate" or "substantial" is officially announced. We will try to make the announcement as early as possible to allow time for planning. If the county returns to "moderate" over the Thanksgiving holiday, we will remain in our current instructional model.

The Pennsylvania Secretary of Health, Dr. Rachel Levine, issued a Travel Order starting today for individuals traveling into and returning back to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Order states that, "... (individuals) must produce a negative SARS-CoV2 (COVID-19) test within 72 hours prior to entering the Commonwealth, or quarantine for 14 days..." **If your family is planning to travel out of State in November or December, please contact your school principal as soon as possible.** We will assist you in navigating the new travel requirements.

Once again, we know the challenges of Full Virtual Learning, but we also understand the importance of keeping our students, staff, communities, and families safe during these challenging times. Full Virtual means students currently in Face to Face instruction will move to Virtual Live; all other students will remain on either Virtual Live or Virtual Recorded instruction.

With the upcoming holidays, please continue to practice all recommended safety protocols including restricting travel, practicing social distancing, wearing Department of Health approved face coverings and washing your hands frequently.
