To register for the PTI bring this form to the Prince George County School Board Office no later than **May 30, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.** *You may not turn in your registration to your school.* Your registration will be marked with the date and time by the receptionist at the school board office. Parents and students may turn in their registration form at the School Board Office any time during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on May 23 – May 30.

PTI Auditions for *Willie Wonka Jr.*

Auditions for *Willie Wonka Jr.* will be **June 5, 2019 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.** in the **Prince George High School Choir Room**

PAAS Vocal and PAAS Theatre students are invited to audition for speaking and singing roles.

Auditions are not mandatory to be part of PTI, only students interested in speaking and singing parts need to be present for auditions.

For auditions, students will perform an excerpt from the show (the music and CD to help you prepare will for pick up at the receptionist desk on a first come first serve basis beginning May 23 from 8:00 am to 5:00. You will also be asked to do a cold read of dialogue from the show and will be taught a short dance routine.

Part 1: Conditions Important!

You must be a PAAS student.

Acceptance is *first come, first serve.*

You **MUST** be available the full 12 day program. (See section 3 below).

- You will receive an acceptance notice when you register as long as you indicate that you are free to attend all 12 days (or at least a minimum of 11) and are one of the first 60 applicants. (A balance must be achieved amongst the three focus areas: theatre, vocal, and art.)
- If you know you will miss more than one day you may still apply but we will give you a waiting list notice when you register. We will call you if the program does not fill to capacity with full time students.
- Once we have 60 students enrolled, applicants will receive a waiting list notice.
- Absences of any length may be cause for removal from the production at the discretion of the director.
- Also, if the program has to be cancelled due to insufficient numbers (fewer than 48) you will also be notified.
- I understand there will be no tuition fee but I may be asked to provide supplies for my child (cost not to exceed \$25.00 per program).
