

Dear Prince George Families,

This afternoon, after much educator input, discussion, and thoughtful review of the Virginia Department of Education's guidance regarding grading including grade point average calculations for those in high school credit bearing courses, our Principals and division leadership team completed the attached grading plans for our elementary and secondary students. These plans were designed to allow for the greatest opportunities for our students to be successful now and in future grade levels and course work. These will also be posted on our division website.

For those students who are interested, optional opportunities to improve third quarter grades will be available following Spring Break. Details about 4th quarter instruction and grading can be found in the attached plans.

Thanks to a generous grant from the John Randolph Foundation, Prince George High School student parking lot and the parking lot directly in front of N.B. Clements are now set up as high-speed internet hotspots for Prince George students. The wi-fi can be accessed by clicking on **pgcps_guest**. An acceptance page will appear and the guest only needs to click on *Accept* to begin access. Additionally, the parking lots of all other Prince George County Public Schools are in the process of being configured for this access. We anticipate all lots will be open for wi-fi access no later than April 24th.

For secondary, a survey by student related to access to internet and devices for students in Grades 8-12 taking high school credit-bearing courses was administered earlier today. This information will be used to determine priorities for supporting students with loans of devices and/or internet access. For those of you with Grade 8-12 students in high school credit-bearing courses who may not have received the survey yet, the link for the survey will also be available on the school's webpage.
