Update: All Virginia Schools Closed Through the End of the School Year and Additional Information

Dear Prince George Families, Faculty, and Staff:

Today, Governor Ralph Northam mandated that all public schools in Virginia will be closed for the remainder of the school year. We recognize that the length of the closure might come as a surprise to many of our families, but we also know that the governor has made this decision after careful consideration of the health and safety of all Virginians.

Also, today the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, Dr. James Lane, shared that the Virginia Department of Education will provide guidance to schools this week regarding completing coursework for the classes the students are currently enrolled in, earning standard credits, graduation requirements, continuity of learning, and the provision of meals for children. Division staff have already begun to plan for the continuity of education during the extended closure. We anticipate additional details and resources will be available on our division website during the week of March 30th.

At this time, we plan to continue to provide meals to all students of Prince George County Public Schools. In an effort to streamline our delivery process, for the remainder of this week through April 3rd, we will be sending out meals to the existing delivery sites and the two sites for pick-up, North Elementary and J.E.J. Moore Middle School, three days each week – Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 11:00 a.m. -12:00 p.m. On Monday, one breakfast and one lunch will be provided for each student. On Tuesday and Thursday, two meals for breakfast and two meals for lunch will be delivered. The delivery schedule is available on our website.

Thank you for all that you are doing to support our community's students.
