Dear Prince George Families:

Prince George County Public Schools (PGCPS) is sampling water from schools throughout the division under the requirements of legislation enacted to ensure that schools have a safe, clean water supply for consumption by students and staff. This sampling is part of a larger program across the state to test for the presence of lead in drinking water. PGCPS is working with the Office of Drinking Water of the Virginia Department of Health, the Virginia Department of Education, as well as our industrial hygiene consultant to ensure the safety of our students and staff.

The EI Group, Inc. Environmental, Health and Safety Solutions serves as our industrial hygiene consultants and recently completed testing at South Elementary School with the letter to families and results posted on the division website. EI will be conducting water sampling for all remaining division schools in the next few weeks. Staff expects all testing to be completed by June 2019. Results will be posted when received. If any areas of remediation are identified, recommendations will be followed, and follow-up testing will be conducted.
