Dear South Families:

School divisions are required to conduct lead testing of potable water to ensure that schools have a safe, clean water supply for consumption by students and staff. This testing was recently completed and 33 samples were taken from sinks and water fountains used for drinking or food preparation throughout the building. The results indicate the water samples meet all regulatory guidelines and regulations, with the exception of sinks in three classrooms. These have been turned off and bottled water has been provided to the classrooms for the students' use while this is being addressed.

The EI Group, Inc. Environmental, Health and Safety Solutions conducted the assessment and has provided recommended actions that are now underway to address the concerns. Following the completion of these recommended actions, follow-up testing will be conducted and reported. A copy of this letter and the results will be posted on the division website.
