



Blue Ribbon Honor Roll Policy

Rationale for Policy Revision:

Current Pinnacle policies include several academic awards but not one which recognizes the academic achievement in maintaining a 4.0 or above for a full academic school year.

Current Policy:

Academic Awards

Gold Honor Roll - Students who have a 3.6-4.0 Grade Point Average during first or second semester qualify for the Gold Honor Roll.

Silver Honor Roll - Students who have a 3.0-3.5 Grade Point Average during the first or second semester qualify for the Silver Honor Roll.

Proposed Policy:

The Pinnacle offers a Blue Ribbon Honor Roll. The blue ribbon honor roll will recognize those students K-12 who have achieved and maintained a 4.0 GPA or higher during an academic year (4 quarters for Elementary students, 2 semesters for Middle School and High School students). The policy will be added to the Pinnacle Parent/Student Handbook beginning in the 2016-17 school year.

Academic Awards

Blue Ribbon Honor Roll- Students who maintain a 4.0 Grade Point Average or above during a full academic school year qualify for the Blue Ribbon Honor Roll.

Gold Honor Roll - Students who have a 3.6-4.0 Grade Point Average during first or second semester qualify for the Gold Honor Roll.

Silver Honor Roll - Students who have a 3.0-3.5 Grade Point Average during the first or second semester qualify for the Silver Honor Roll.
