

TEXTBOOK SELECTION AND ADOPTION

The Board of Education is responsible for the selection and designation of all textbooks to be used in the district schools. The Superintendent of Schools shall recommend suitable lists of textbooks to be used in the schools for the Board's consideration.

Texts, once approved by the Board, shall not be superseded for a period of five years, except by a three-fourth's vote of the Board.

The Superintendent shall establish regulations, including criteria and procedures for the selection and recommendation of textbooks, and shall determine a method for selecting staff members serve in the selection and recommendation process.
