

HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Homebound instruction is provided to students who are unable to attend school due to medical, emotional or disciplinary problems. Secondary students shall receive instruction for at least two hours per day and elementary students receive at least one hour per day. Students shall receive credit for their work while on homebound instruction.

The district makes provisions for homebound instruction upon referral from the Medical Director or the Assistant Superintendent for Education Support Services following the guidelines established by the Superintendent of Schools for placing a student on homebound instruction.
