

## TRANSPORTATION FOR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS

The Board shall provide transportation to nonpublic school students residing in the district who meet the district's transportation eligibility requirements. Such students attending nonpublic schools outside of school district boundaries are eligible for transportation as long as the nonpublic school is located within the mileage limitations permitted by law or authorized by district voters.

Transportation requests for students attending nonpublic schools shall be made in writing and received by the Director of Transportation no later than the April 1st preceding the beginning of the next school year. If a student moves into the district later than April 1st, the request should be received within thirty days of establishing residence in the district, but preferably no later than August 1st.

All late requests, however, shall be considered by the Board of Education on the basis of each case's merits. Criteria used by the Board in judging whether to accept a late request may include but not be limited to the following:

1. whether transportation will require an additional cost, and/or
2. the reasonableness of the excuse for the late request.
