

**SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION POLICY**

A. Mandated

Transportation will be provided to students with disabilities as may be required in accordance with the student's individualized education program (IEP).

B. Temporary/Special

In addition, a student may on occasion have a temporary injury or illness that renders such student unable to utilize the school bus transportation to and from school as regularly provided to him/her by the District. In such instances, upon written request of the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) submitted with an appropriate written certification by the student's physician, the District will make reasonable efforts to provide temporary special transportation for such student, provided that the District has an available bus driver and an available and appropriate alternate vehicle. The provision of such temporary special transportation shall be determined in the discretion of the District. Authorization for such transportation must be referred to the Assistant Superintendent for Business and Operations, who shall review the matter and, if it is approved and possible, make arrangements for transportation through the Supervisor of Transportation. A student's schedule may be modified if necessary for the provision of such temporary special transportation.
