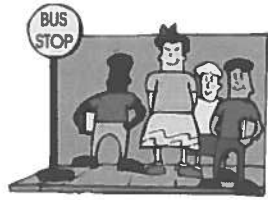

Student(s) crossing a road, please follow these directions.

Students should stop

- Before the roadway in the morning so the bus driver is able to see to see you.
 - Stand 12 feet away from the road at the front of the bus morning and afternoon

Wait for a signal from the driver

- ❖ to enter the roadway in front of the bus in the morning
- to cross the other lane in the afternoon

Obey the signal from the bus driver

It is illegal for a student to cross a road or street at a bus stop who has not been directed to do so by that student's bus driver or school official. Parents should supervise their child/children at the bus stop both morning and afternoon.

Bus Rules for 2016-2017

Students and Parents

Please keep this for your future reference.

Dependable

- Arrive at bus stop 5 minutes before scheduled time
- Always be able to see the bus driver (so they can see you)
- Stand 12 feet away from the road.
- Wait for the bus to stop and for the driver's signal for when it is safe to cross from where you are standing.
- Cross 12 feet in front of the bus
- When getting on the bus, always look for moving cars.
- When the danger signal (blowing of the bus horn) is given, look for the danger of passing cars that do not stop.
- Remain quiet at railroad crossings

Respectful and Productive

- Remain seated while the bus is in motion.
- Keep hands, feet and objects to self and inside the bus
- Follow all instructions given by driver
- Use appropriate language
- Protect school property
- Remain in assigned seat
- Put all food and drink away

Involved

- Use low voice
- Stay seated with feet on the floor and book bag in lap
- Enter and exit bus in orderly fashion

Excellent

- Follow all school and board policies outlined in the student handbook.

*** Disciplinary actions will follow the guidelines in the student handbook and the Georgia Official Code of Law and will be implemented by the administrator at your school.**

Georgia Code 20-2-1181: It shall be unlawful for any person to disrupt or interfere with the operation of any public school, public school bus, or public school bus stop as designated by local school boards of education. Any person violating this code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature.
