The Island Park School District Department of Recreation offers students in grades 5 – 8 Friday night Teen Center. Any student that lives in the Island Park School District on a full-time basis is eligible for this drop-off program. All sessions are supervised by qualified recreation staff with current certification in CPR, AED and Epi-pen. Each session has a theme. The program includes basketball, board games, contests with prizes, flag football, music, ping pong, soccer, special events, video games and the annual Valentine’s Day Dance. Best of all, you will be socializing with your friends and may even make new ones!

**Fee: \$50.00 for 10 sessions**

The Department of Recreation must have a permission slip signed with payment by October 12, 2018, which is one week prior to the start of the program. This request is made in order to have enough staff on hand. The Department of Recreation does offer a 2-payment plan of paying \$25.00 before October 12, 2018 and then the remaining balance before January 4, 2019. Payment may be made with cash, check or credit card. (VISA/MASTERCARD only).
