TUITION CONTRACT AMENDMENT

BETWEEN

ISLAND PARK UFSD

and

LONG BEACH CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

TUITION CONTRACT AMENDMENT

AGREEMENT, made as of the 21 day of May, 2018, by and between the ISLAND PARK UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT ("Island Park") and the LONG BEACH CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT ("Long Beach").

WHEREAS, by way of Agreement dated April 16, 2008, Island Park and Long Beach entered into a contract to allow Island Park students to be enrolled into Long Beach upon terms agreed upon by the parties for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2013 (the "2008 Contract"); and

WHEREAS, prior to the expiration of the 2008 Contract, the parties extended such contract for five (5) years ("1st Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, such 2008 Contract and 1st Amendment will expire on June 30, 2018, and the parties wish to extend the contract for an additional year;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, Island Park and Long Beach hereby agree, as follows:

1. **2008 Contract and 1st Amendment**

All of the terms of the 2008 Contract and 1st Amendment are hereby extended and incorporated into this Agreement except as is more specifically delineated herein. The 2008 Contract and 1st Amendment are incorporated by reference and attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

2. **Period of Contract**

This Contract will take effect on July 1, 2018 and shall expire on June 30, 2019.

3. **Students to be Educated**

All Island Park students who are already attending Long Beach in accordance with the 2008 Contract or 1st Amendment. In addition, all Island Park Students becoming 9th graders in the 2018-2019 school year electing to attend Long Beach High School. Island Park will provide Long Beach with a list of such students by June 1, 2018.

4. **Tuition Amount**

- A. With respect to all Island Park students attending Long Beach High School in the 2018-2019 school year, Island Park agrees to pay Long Beach one hundred (100%) percent of the tuition amount that may be charged in accordance with the Education Law and the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education (part 174) pursuant to the New York State non-resident tuition rate (hereinafter "Seneca Falls Rate").

- B. All of the other tuition provisions in the 2008 Contract that are not inconsistent with the above provisions; namely, paragraphs B through G of Article III, remain equally applicable.

5. Transportation

To the extent Long Beach provides late bus transportation to its resident students, similar transportation shall be provided to Island Park students.

6. Special Education Procedures

With reference to Island Park students having a disability in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities in Education Act (IDEA) and corresponding state regulations, the following procedures shall be followed:

- A. The Long Beach high school special education staff shall provide the Special Education Coordinator of the Island Park School District with all notifications to parents (i.e. prior written notice, dates of CSE meetings). These notifications will be sent to Island Park in the same time frame that they are sent to parents.
- B. Island Park administrators can, at their discretion, participate in all CSE meetings for Island Park students during the course of their years in high school. Long Beach High School will provide written notice of all such meetings to the Island Park Special Education Coordinator.

7. Miscellaneous

This Contract shall be submitted to the District Superintendent for the Supervisory District and shall, in accordance with the New York State Education Law, not be binding until approved by the District Superintendent to the Supervisory District with a copy to the Commissioner of Education and approved by him.
