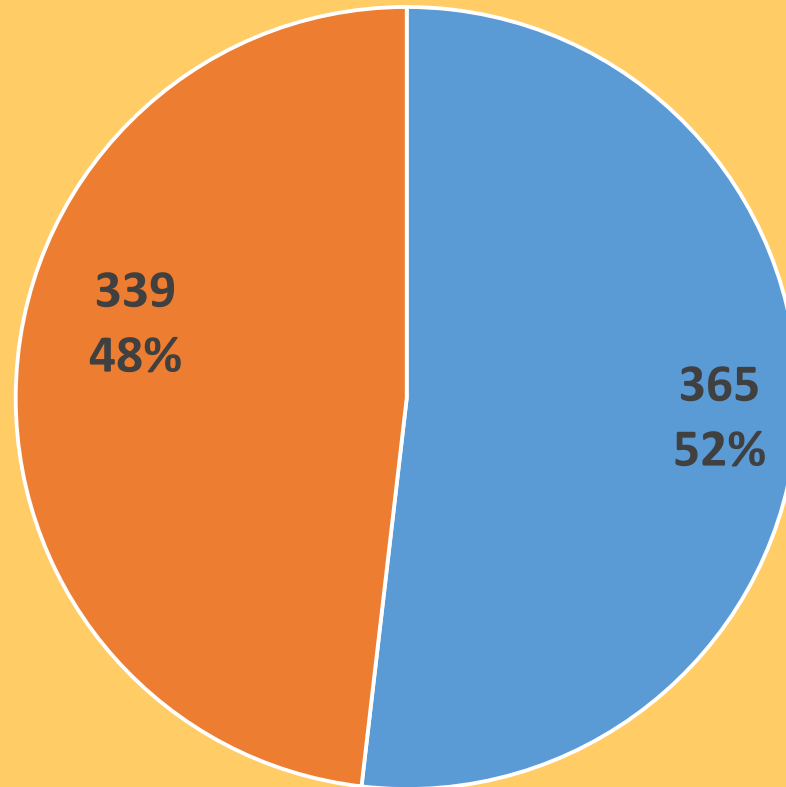

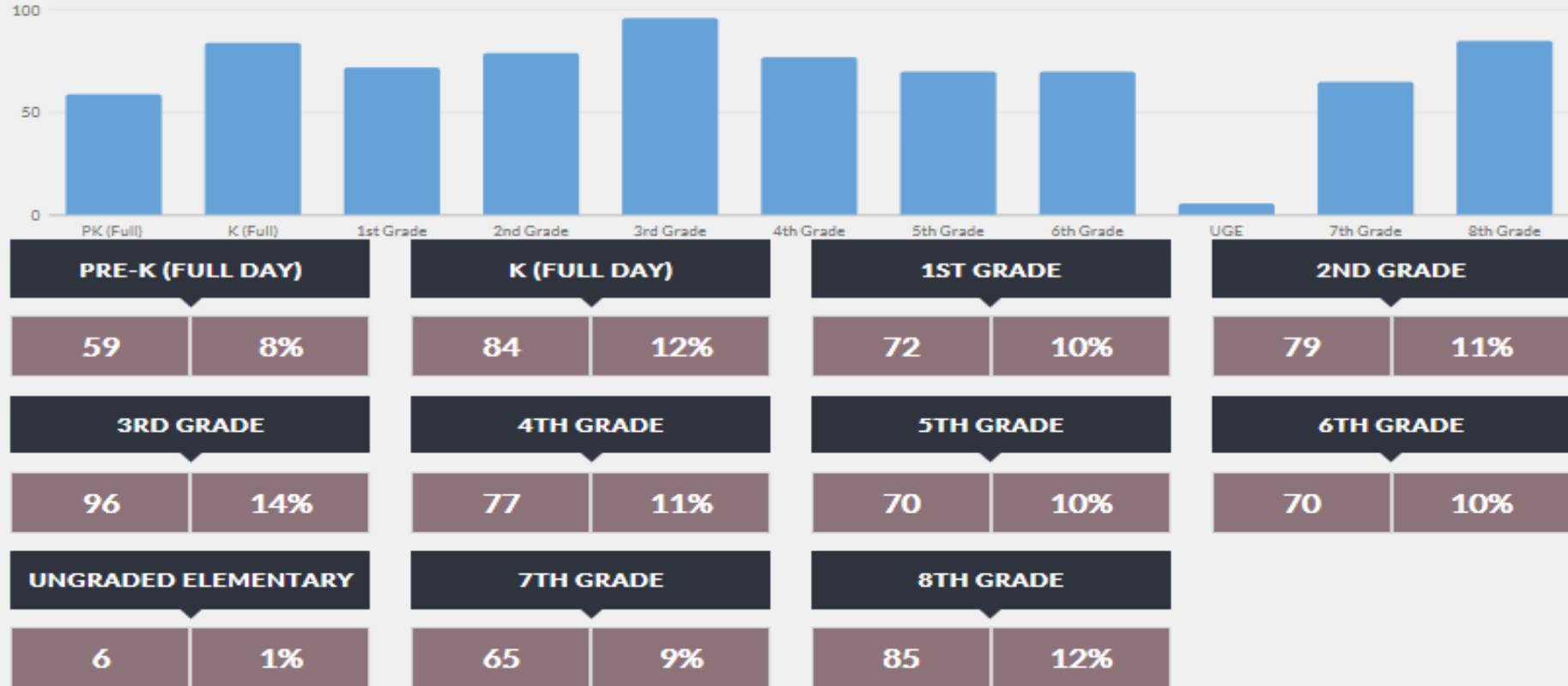

Enrollment: Females and Males

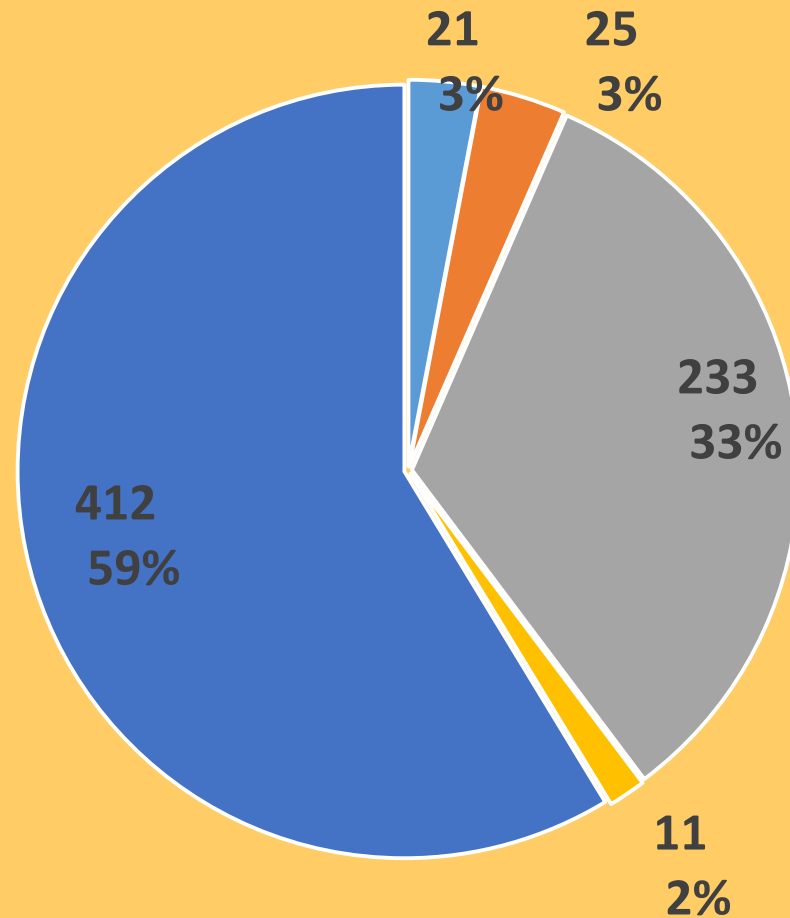

 Af-Am/Black

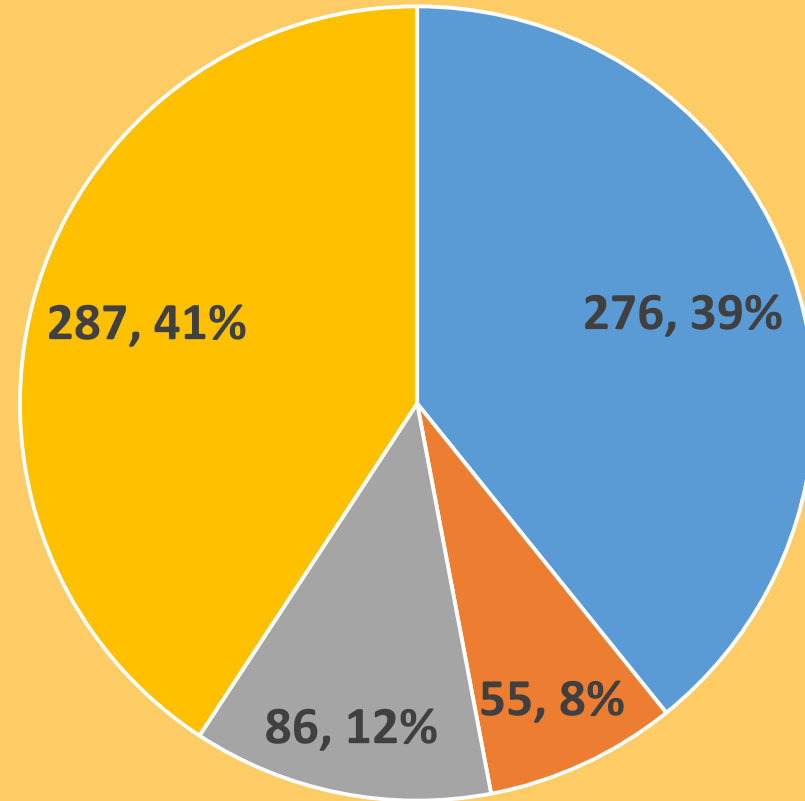

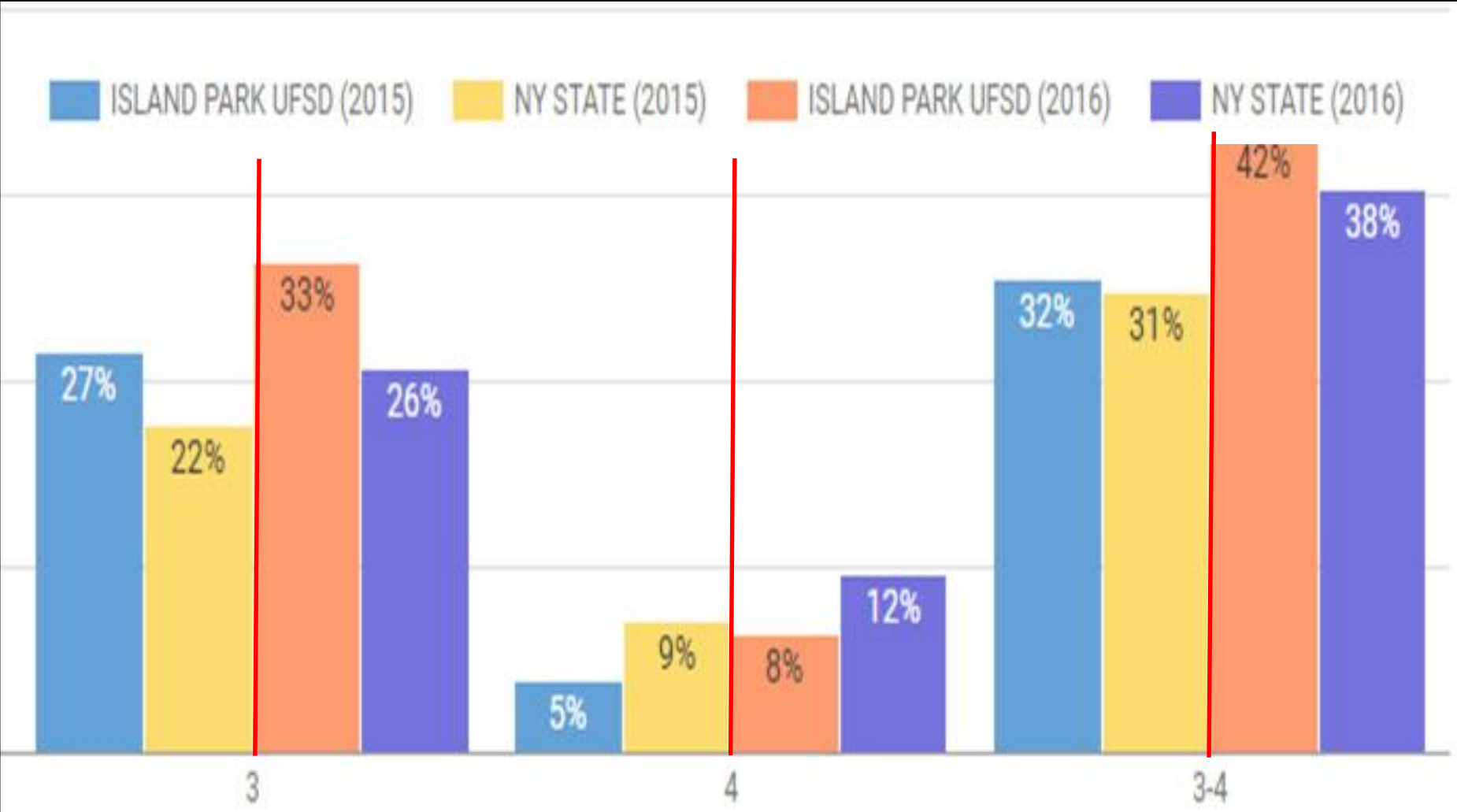

Types of Learners and State Aid Weightings



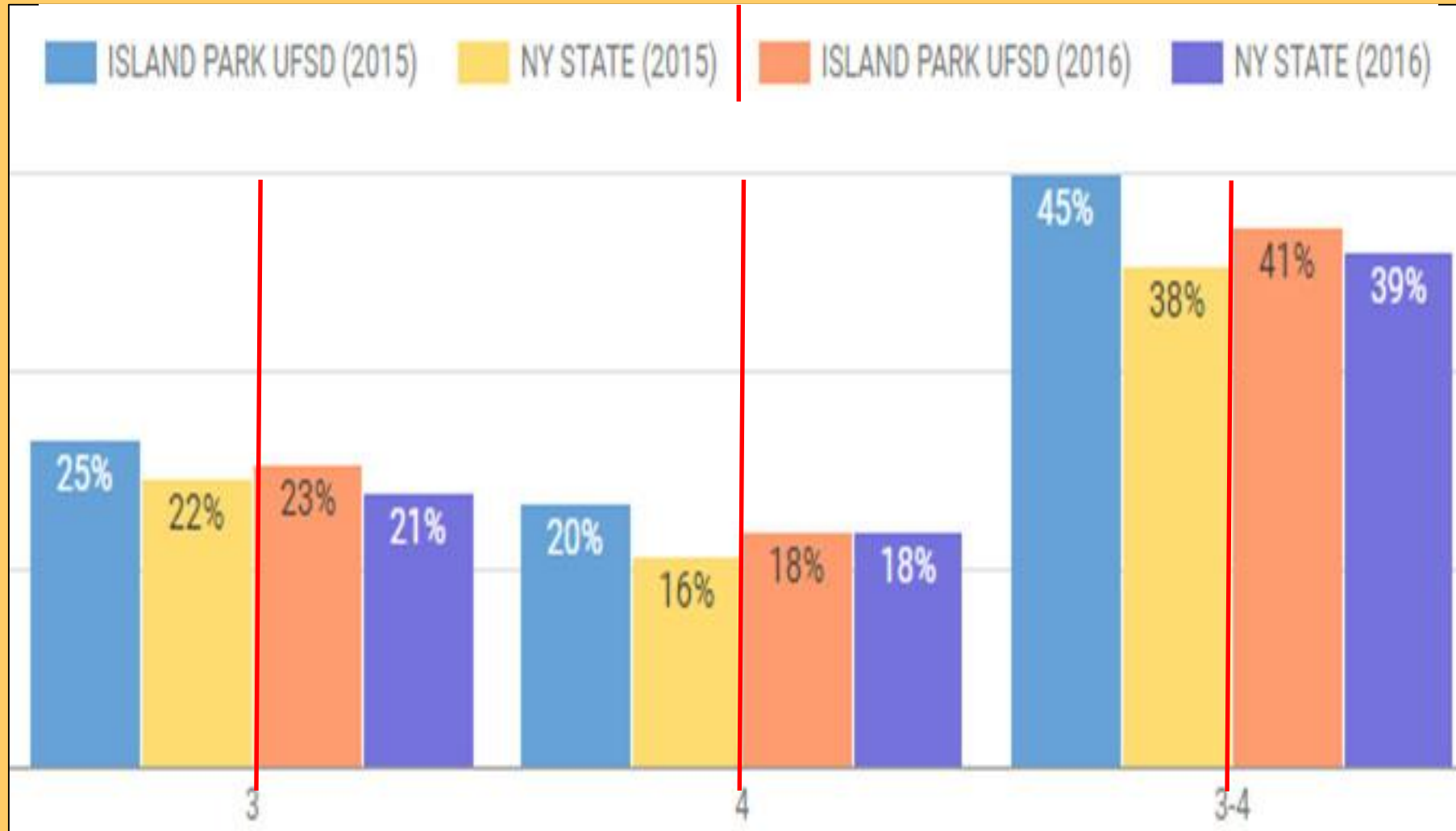

Refusals: 46.69%

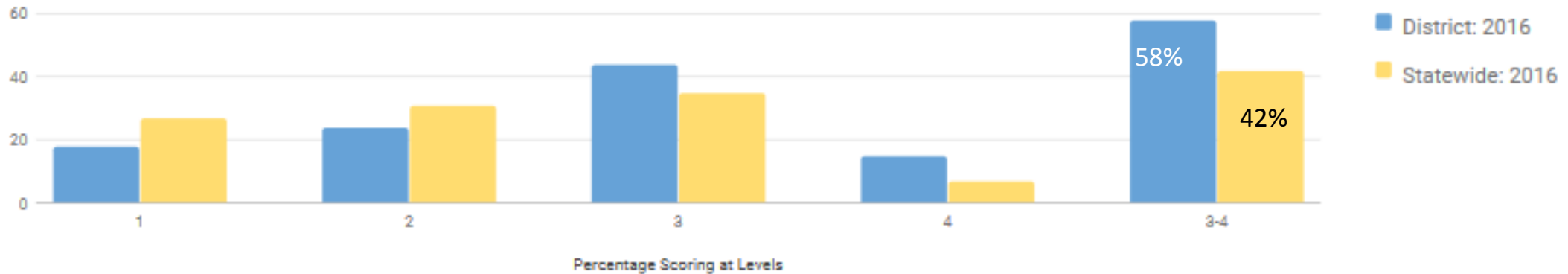
Math Levels 3 and 4: 2015 and 2016



Refusals: 49.67%

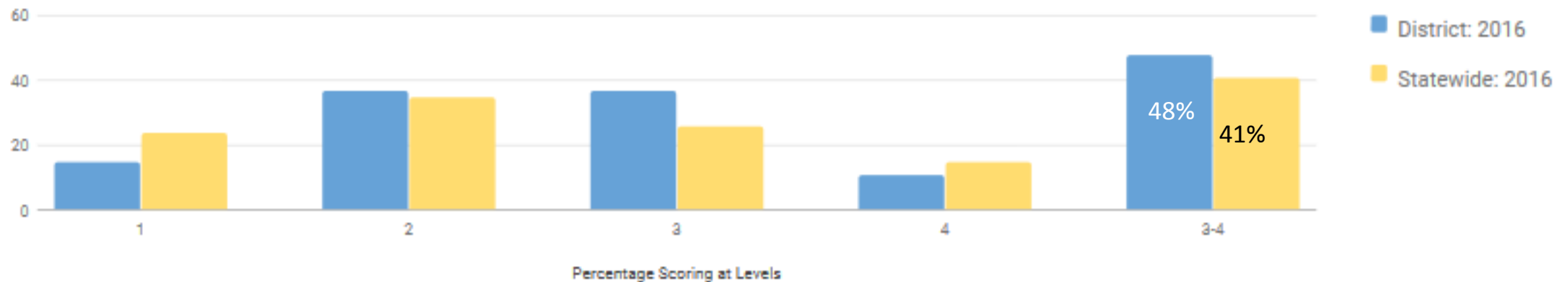

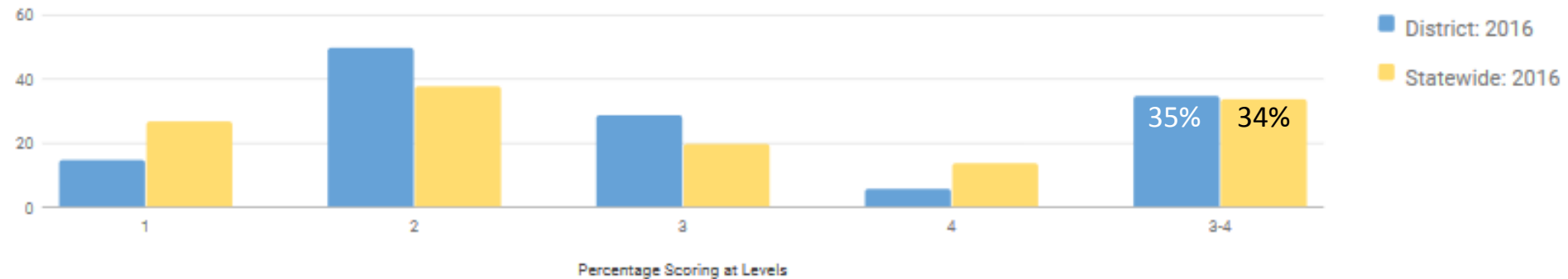

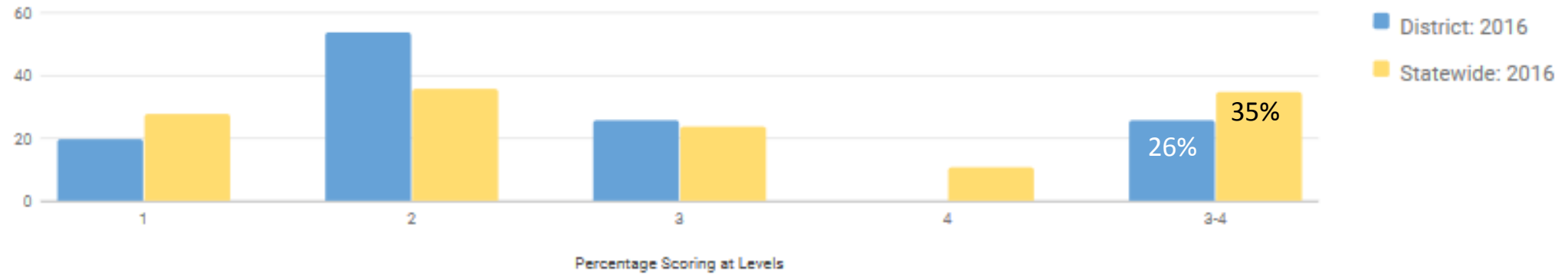

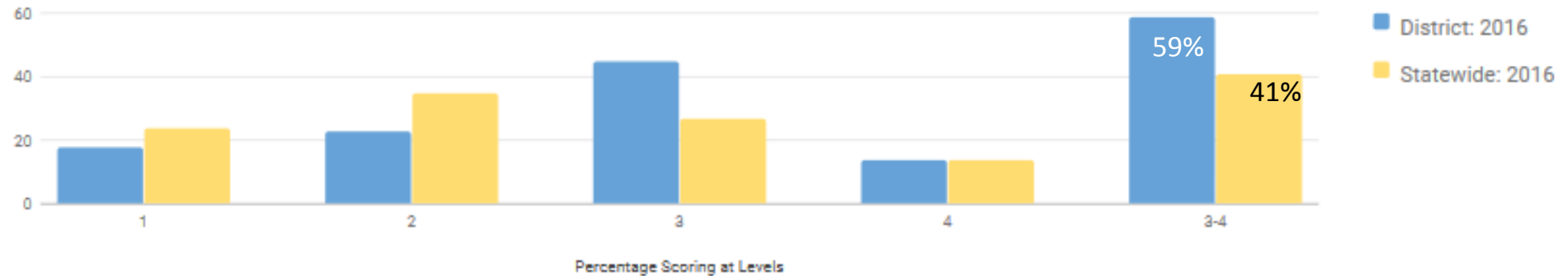

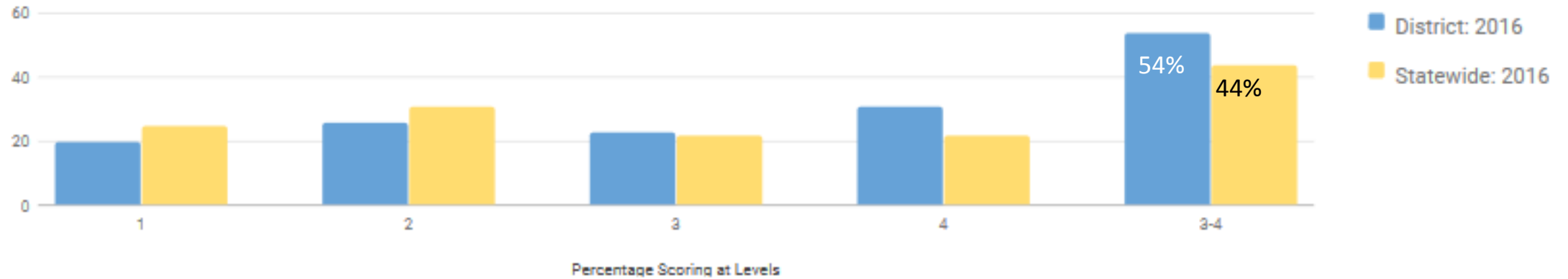

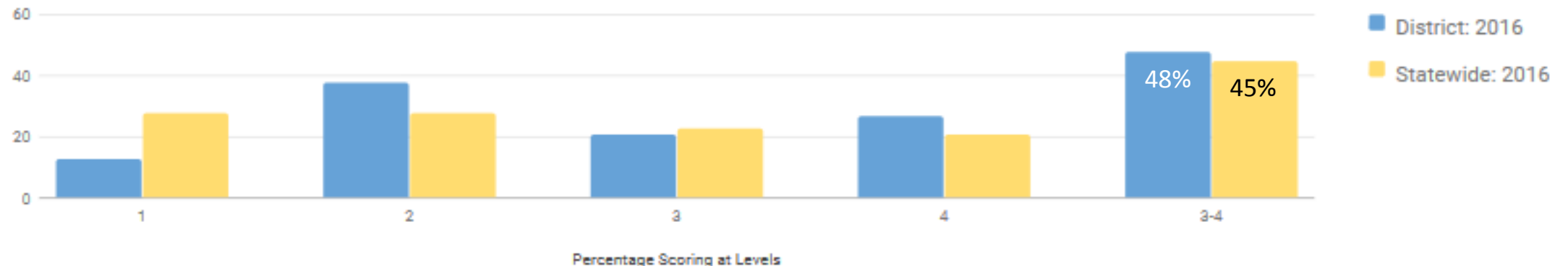

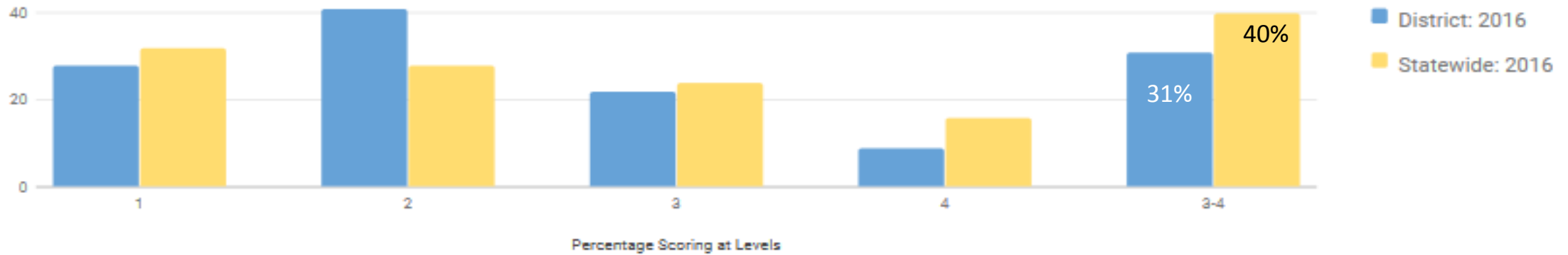

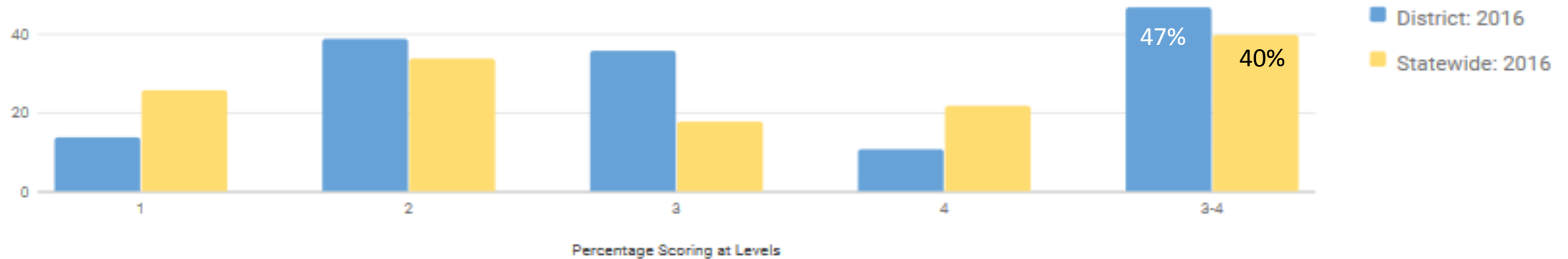

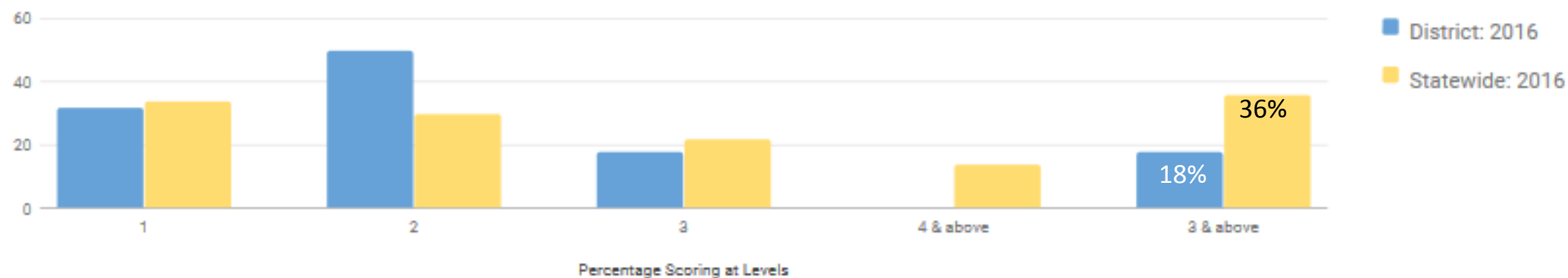

Students performing at this level partially meet Common Core expectations (required for Local Diploma purposes). (No one scored lower than 73%)

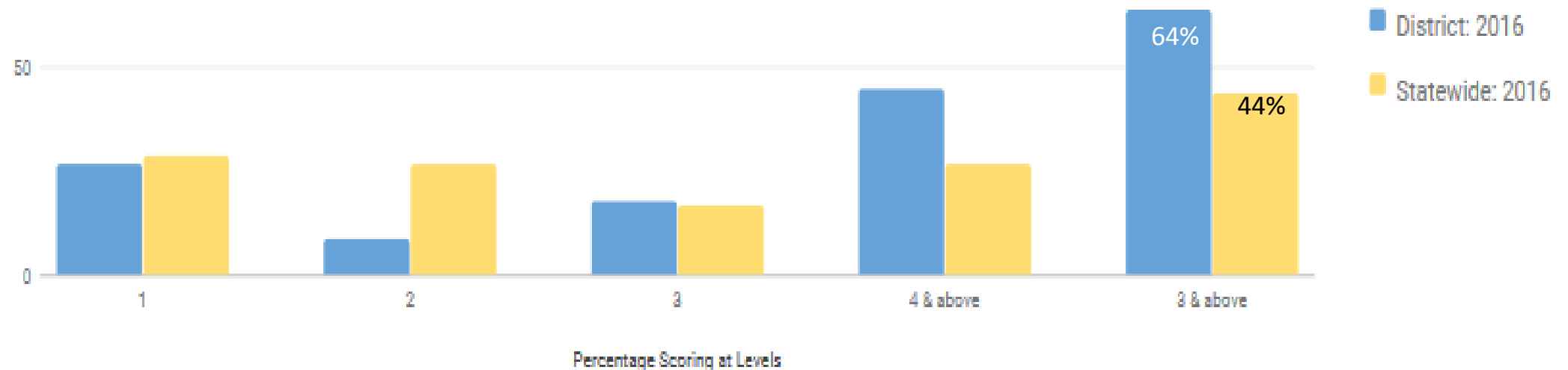
NYS Level 1

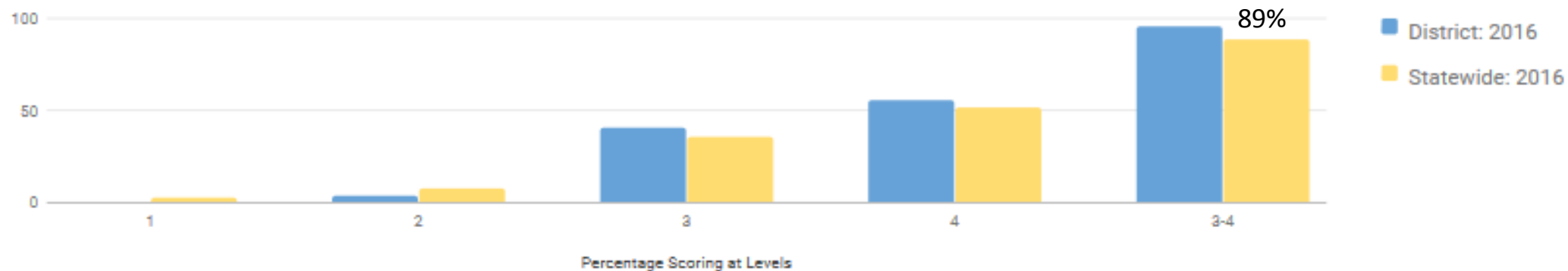


Summary: Grade 8 Math and Integrated Algebra

- Grade 8 Students: (Enrollment 88 students)
- Only 12 students took the grade 8 math exam.
- 6 of 12 (50%) are in “poverty”, 3 (25%) are LEP All 12 scored either Level 1 or 2
- 22 students took the Int. Algebra Regents exam
- 2 / 22 (9.1%) are in “poverty” **We need to increase the number of accelerated students.**
- 6 / 22 (27.3%) scored Level 3
- 16 / 22 (72.7%) Scored 4 or 5

GRADE 4 SCIENCE

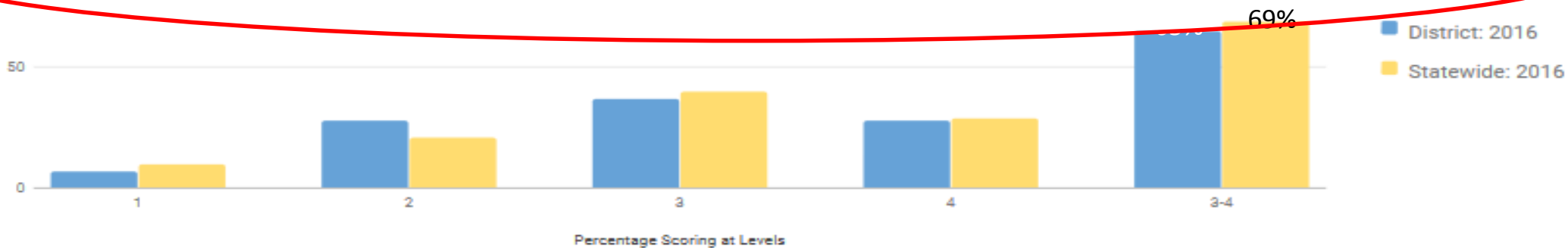

- Grade 8 Students: (Enrollment 88 students)
- Only 32 students (27.5%) took the grade 8 science exam.
- 16 of the 32 (50%) are in “poverty”, 3 are LEP 19 / 32 (59.4%) scored either Level 1 or 2
- 12 / 32 (37.5%) scored Level 3; 1 / 32 (3.1%) scored Level 4
- 22 students took the Living Environment Regents exam
- 2 / 22 (9%) are in “poverty” **We need to increase number of accelerated students.**
- 8 / 22 (36%) scored Level 3; 14 / 22 (64%) Scored level 4
