WINTER 2019 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

MAIL-IN REGISTRATION for all Youth and Adult Programs:

Mail-in registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. These should be received at least one week prior to the start date of the activity. Mail registrations are not confirmed. Presume you are accepted in your selected course unless you receive notice to the contrary.

REGISTER EARLY:

If we do not receive enough registrations for a program, we may have to cancel it for the season!

REGISTRATION FORMS ARE FOUND IN THE BACK OF THE BROCHURE.

WHO MAY REGISTER:

Both residents and non-residents of the Island Park School District. Non-residents pay an additional \$20.00 fee for youth programs and an additional \$25.00 fee for adult programs.

SENIOR CITIZENS:

Seniors that reside in Island Park and are 65 years or older are entitled to take a course free of charge with the exception of courses offered by outside agencies or computer courses.

IN-PERSON REGISTRATIONS:

For those who are unable to register during the day, there will be a registration night on Thursday, January 3, 2019 from 5:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. at Lincoln Orens Middle School. You may also register in person at the Recreation Office Monday-Friday from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm. All daily registrations must schedule an appointment. Please call the office at 434-2605 and leave a message. The district's visitor policy is always enforced. Please read it on the district's web site, www.ips.k12.ny.us. (see Quick Links). All visitors must have official photo identification to enter the building.

PAYMENTS:

The Island Park School District Department of Recreation accepts cash, check and/or MasterCard/Visa. If paying cash, please have the exact amount. The office cannot provide change. All registrants making payments at Lincoln Orens Middle School must have an appointment.

REFUNDS:

Once a program begins, there are NO refunds. Refunds will only be given if a program is cancelled due to low enrollment.

PARKING:

Parking is provided in the front and side lots of the Lincoln Orens Middle School. Parking at F.X. Hegarty Elementary School is available on Radcliffe Road and in the lot adjacent to the Conference Center.

SECURITY:

The main entrance for FXH is on Deal Rd and for LOMS, on Trafalgar Blvd. A security aide will admit students into the buildings. Adults entering the buildings must present a valid picture ID e.g., driver's license, passport, etc.
