**UPK Selection**

Dr. Bovino stated that the district has a Universal Pre-K Program for four-year olds. We are awarded \$600,000 annually. The district is allocated 60 placements (\$10,000 per child). The District ran UPK registrations for the 2018-2019 school year in February and again in May. To date, we have 58 children and 2 vacancies. As of today we have four completed applications. Our policy stipulates that all completed applications must be presented to the Board at its next regular Board meeting. Therefore, as per the procedures for selecting students to fill the vacancies, a drawing by lottery was performed by the Board President. The student's names that were randomly drawn are: 1) Vida Verdino, 2) Ava Rechulsky, 3) Riis Marlin and 4) Steven Pinco. The parents of Vida Verdino and Ava Rechulsky will be notified by the Principal of the Francis X. Hegarty School of their children's acceptance into the UPK Program for September 2018. The parents of Riis Marlin and Steven Pinco will be notified that should openings occur Riis Marlin is first to be called; Steven Pinco is second to be called.

On a motion duly made by Diana Caracciolo, seconded by Tara Byrne, resolved that the meeting be adjourned. Upon vote, motion unanimously carried. Said meeting adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
