Flossmoor School District 161 is pleased to offer Summer Academy for Kindergarten through 7th grade students.

Summer Academy classes are designed to help students build skills in language arts and mathematics over the summer months. Classes offer a half day of enrichment and support in language arts and mathematics. Classes will meet Monday - Thursday from June 18th - July 26th. A virtual summer program for language arts and mathematics is also available.

Registration

Current District 161 students can register by mail until May 18th. All summer academy fees must accompany registration. Mail the registration form and fees to Kathy Kalmes, Parker Junior High School
2810 School Street, Flossmoor, IL 60422. Students must be enrolled by May 19th in order to be admitted. Sign up early to assure your child a spot in the 2018 Flossmoor District 161 Summer Academy.

Location

All classes will be held at Western Avenue Elementary School, located at 940 Western Avenue, Flossmoor, IL 60422.

Transportation

District 161 will provide an optional bus service for the summer program. Bus pick-up occurs in the morning between approximately 7:40-8:20 a.m. Bus drop-off is offered after school. There is a fee for bus service of \$50. Transportation fees are non-refundable.

Enrollment

Children who are District 161 residents and who have completed grades kindergarten through 7 may attend the summer program. Students who are in 8th grade and have been mandated to attend due to a failing grade are also eligible.

Children do not need to attend District 161 schools to register, but all children who are enrolled must be residents. Students not currently attending Flossmoor School District 161 will be required to present a current physical with up-to-date immunizations and proof of residency at the time of registration.

Tuition Fees and Course Changes

There is a fee of \$100 for summer academy, and a \$60 fee for the virtual summer enrichment program. All classes are taught by certified teachers. Tuition fees are non-refundable except in the case of medical reasons or course cancellations due to insufficient enrollment or instructor availability.

Tuition fees should be combined and paid at the time of registration. Make checks payable to Flossmoor School District 161. Fees are waived for tuition and transportation for any students who have a District-approved fee waiver on file.

Virtual Summer Enrichment Opportunity

Flossmoor School District 161 will be offering a virtual summer enrichment opportunity. Students enrolled in this program will have a 'virtual' check in with their teacher as well as in-person meetings with the enrichment teacher throughout the summer. Students will have daily requirements to complete at their own pace in this program. A virtual Pre-Algebra course will also be offered.

The cost of this enrichment opportunity will be \$60 for the six week summer session. Parents will be responsible for bringing the student to school for face to face meetings, establishing a daily routine at home for students to complete work, and communicating with the teacher as necessary. *Please note: Transportation and fee waivers are not available for this program.

Course Minimums

A minimum number of students must be enrolled in each class. Parents will be notified if enrollment minimums are not met and classes must be cancelled.

Attendance

Students are expected to attend summer academy classes once they are enrolled.

Emergency

The Summer Academy Health Information Form and the Emergency Information section on the registration form must be completed to register.
