Black Butte High School

- Enrollment procedures – Black Butte High School is an open enrollment high school in Sweetwater County School District #1. Black Butte has an enrollment capacity of 100 students. Students interested in enrolling in Black Butte must complete an enrollment packet. Enrollment packets are available in the Black Butte High School office, Rock Springs High School office, and Rock Springs Junior High office. The deadline for initial enrollment for Black Butte fall semester is May 1st. The deadline for initial enrollment for Black Butte spring semester is December 1st. A lottery system will be utilized in the event that the number of enrollment packets received by the May 1st or December 1st initial enrollment deadlines would cause Black Butte to exceed its capacity of 100 students. A lottery drawing will be conducted to determine initial enrollment and to determine the order of a waiting list. Students submitting completed enrollment packets after the May 1st or December 1st deadline may still be enrolled provided that Black Butte has not reached its capacity of 100 students. If Black Butte has reached its capacity, these students will be placed on the waiting list in the order their completed enrollment packet is received. Students on the waiting list will be subject to the enrollment process for subsequent semesters including the lottery system if necessary.

**Career/College Readiness (CCR) Syllabus
District Policy IF Educational Program Development
(Pilot Class)**

Purpose: The purpose of the RSHS CCR period is to provide support, intervention, and enrichment for students at all grade levels. As well, this course is designed to ensure our students will be productive global citizens, career and college ready, have a healthy lifestyle and excellent interpersonal skills, and to be life-long learners.

Credit: .125 per semester (elective credit only)
Pass/Fail grade assigned

Class-level meetings: Each grade level will have a minimum of one meeting per month with building administration with the registration process also occurring during this time.

Delivery of instruction: Certified teachers within the building at RSHS will teach each of the topics.
