

**The Rock Springs High School Seal
is
89 Years Old
in
2016**

The Rock Springs High School Seal, created in 1927 by students, is the same familiar symbol in 2016 as in 1927.

In the late spring of 1927 the RSHS Student Council decided that a school seal would be a valuable addition to the symbolism of the school. They agreed the seal would represent the chief industry of the city at that time.

A pick and shovel became part of the emblem and a few sprigs of sagebrush were added to portray the character of the surrounding country. An open book and a torch of knowledge depicted scholarship, while a loving cup represented sportsmanship, comradeship and loyalty.

The fall of 1927 was the first display of the seal. Today, the seal is seen at various places in School District Number One including at the high school.
