The Superintendent recommends action on the following matters. Resolved that

1. The resignation of Lauren Martinez, Elementary Teacher at the Middle School, be accepted effective May 11, 2018.
2. The resignation of Rosann Guido, Science Teacher at the High School, be accepted effective August 31, 2018.
3. The resignation of Diana Gonzalez, Elementary Teacher at John F Kennedy School, be accepted effective August 31, 2018.
4. The resignation of Joseph Capalbo as Co-Mathematics Academic Learning Specialist – Middle School be accepted effective March 14, 2018.
5. The appointment of Melissa Pennino as Co-Mathematics Academic Learning Specialist – Middle School be modified to Mathematics Academic Learning Specialist effective March 14, 2018.
6. The February 13, 2018 appointment of Sandra Clohessy be modified as follows: Sandra Clohessy, New Windsor, New York, be approved for a four-year probationary appointment as School Business Administrator, in the School Business Administrator tenure area, according to the terms of employment, effective July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2022. Mrs. Clohessy received a B.B.A. Degree and a M.S. Ed. Degree from Pace University. Her assignment will be in the Business Office and will include participation in designated school related organizational activities. Her certification is School District Business Leader – Professional Certification.
7. The leave of absence granted at the March 20, 2018 board meeting granted to Stephanie Sumcizk from her Special Education tenure area teaching position effective March 14, 2018 through June 23, 2018 be rescinded and she be reinstated to her Special Education Teacher position.
