The Superintendent recommends action on the following matters. Resolved that

1. The appointment at the August 1, 2018 Board of Education meeting of Danielle Salera, Bedford, New York be amended to a two-year probationary appointment from a four-year probationary appointment as Elementary Teacher, at Step 3-Level 6 of the 2015-2019 Teachers Collectively Negotiated Agreement, effective September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2020, except to the extent required by Section 3012-d of the Education Law.* Ms. Salera previously served two years and received APPR scores in Port Chester School District. Ms. Salera received a B.A. Degree and a M.A. Degree from Manhattanville College. Ms. Salera received NYS Fingerprint Clearance for Employment September 15, 2014. Her assignment will be at the Elementary Schools and will include participation in designated school related organizational activities. Her certifications are Early Childhood Education (Birth-Grade 2) – Initial Certification and Students with Disabilities (Birth-Grade 2) – Initial Certification.

*** In order to be granted tenure, a classroom teacher must receive composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Education Law §3012-c and/or §3012-d of either effective or highly effective in at least 3 of the 4 preceding years. Further, if the classroom teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period he/she shall not be eligible for tenure at that time, in which case the Board of Education, in its discretion, may extend the teacher’s probationary term for an additional year.**

Hari Golden-Low, Rye Brook, New York, be approved as a Long Term Substitute Teacher to replace Stephanie Mann at the Middle School, beginning approximately March 22, 2019 through June 5, 2019 at an anticipated daily rate of \$100. If this assignment continues past 20 working days, the daily rate will increase to \$125.
