Representations from Fuller D’Angelo Architects Planners Joseph Fuller, Frank DiFato, and Said Zomorrodian presented the schematic designs and design development completed to date for building projects at Edison, Park Avenue, King Street School, John F. Kennedy Elementary School and Port Chester High School

A Question and Answer period ensued. It was noted that construction is expected to start on or about July 2018 with project completion expected fall 2020.
