BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education award the bid for Marching Band Uniforms to Fruhauf Uniforms, INC. as the lowest responsible bidder responsive to the specifications as stipulated in the bid documents.

RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of the Port Chester-Rye Union Free School District, pursuant to General Municipal Law § 6-p, authorize the District Treasurer to transfer an amount, not to exceed \$1,000,000 from the Undesignated Fund Balance of the 2017-2018 fiscal year to the employee benefit accrued liability reserve.
- I. RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of the Port Chester-Rye Union Free School District, pursuant to Education Law §3651 (1-a), authorize the District Treasurer to transfer an amount, not to exceed \$1,000,000 from the Undesignated Fund Balance of the 2017-2018 fiscal year to a reserve for tax certioraris.
- J. RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of the Port Chester-Rye Union Free School District, pursuant to General Municipal Law § 6-r, authorize the District Treasurer to transfer an amount, not to exceed \$1,500,000 from the Undesignated Fund Balance of the 2017-2018 fiscal year to the retirement contribution reserve fund which was established September 15, 2005.
